Retrieving Packets

City Council Packets are available online. Your surface has a shortcut on the desktop to the meetings which can take you to those packets.



This shortcut will take you directly to the meetings, where you can find entries like the following:



When you click on the Packet, it will open within Edge. This may work for small packets but downloading and opening the packet with Acrobat will give you more navigation options. The save icon is located to the right.



By default, documents will be saved to your local My Documents folder. This is important, because once you have saved the packet locally, marked it up, and wish to reference it again, going to the website to retrieve it will not include the comments.

Creating subfolders in documents can make finding packets later easier. Pick an organization strategy that works best for you.



Now that the packet has been saved to your surface, open the packet in Acrobat Reader DC.

Opening Packets

Click the Start button in the bottom left corner



Click on Documents icon



Double click on the packet to open it in Acrobat Reader.

Once the packet is open in Adobe Reader, enable the comments toolbar and the side panel. This option is located on the right panel.




This button enables 2 things. First the markup toolbar:



This toolbar enables adding annotations, drawings, comments, shapes, and other changes to the local copy of the pdf that can be accessed later.

The second change with commenting enabled is the comment navigation to the right:




This pane allows you to jump in the pdf to a previous comment, including searching for notes entered.

Making Comments


There are a few helpful buttons on the comment toolbar that can be used to mark up the packets on your surface. If you want to write directly on the page (and the background), use the pen icon.



The pen is a convenient option when using the included surface pen, it allows complete flexibility to draw and write. What you write using the pen is recorded as individual strokes, it does not allow you to search for your comments later. You can follow up on these notes by adding a reply in the comment pane.



The pen can be styled with color




To make comments that are searchable and summarized, use the sticky note or highlight tools:




Sticky notes are noted with a icon within the document, and highlight will emphasize text. After adding a sticky note to the document, a pop-up appears where you add your note.



The note appears when you hover the mouse over the . If you tap the the note becomes highlighted in the comment pane.



Highlight text to add comments relevant to a section. Click on the highlight icon text that you wish to comment on.



Saving and Reopening

Once your comments are complete, use the save



Open your documents and find the packet by the date to open
