



Current Projects Update

AWIA Risk and Resiliency Assessment (RRA) – Project completed by 12/31/21 deadline!

Water Master Plan – on schedule, City staff currently completing hydrant testing

Stormwater Master Plan – in progress, currently planning public outreach efforts

Wastewater Treatment Plant

- Design proceeding very quickly for Phases 1 and 2 in parallel.
- Targeting bidding Phase 1 in late spring/early summer.

WTP Finished Water and Backwash Pumping Project

- Pacific Excavation is General Contractor
- Pre-Construction Conference scheduled for Wednesday

2022 Small Diameter Water Main Replacement/Overlay Projects – In Design

WTP Standby Generator Project – currently scoping preliminary design

Pacific Power Study

- City Commissioned Resiliency Study in 2021
- 3 options presented for WTP Resiliency
 - 1. Standard Resiliency (Genset Only)
 - Enhanced Resiliency (Genset + Battery)
 - 3. Comprehensive Resiliency (Genset + Battery + Solar)
- Significant Potential Funding Sources:
 - FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)
 - Can provide up to 75% of project funding
 - Energy Trust of Oregon
 - Oregon Department of Energy
 - Pacific Power Community Resiliency Program

Approx. Cost of Options

- Standard Resiliency (New WTP Genset Only)
 - \$1.0M+ as previously discussed with Council
- 2. Enhanced Resiliency
 - \$2.0M for Genset + Battery
- 3. Comprehensive Resiliency
 - \$3.0M for Genset + Battery + Solar
- Greater resiliency = Greater potential for outside funding
 - Option 1: City funds \$1.0M
 - **Option 2:** City funds 25% of \$2.0M = \$500,000
 - **Option 3:** City funds 25% of \$3.0M = \$750,000
- Sweet Home may be only current applicant for \$1.6M of available Pacific Power funding.
 - These funds could potentially provide the additional 25% match for FEMA funding

Timing is a key consideration

- City has ARPA funding available now which could be used to install the Genset immediately
- Pursuit of FEMA funding would take time: 1 year on the low side
- If outside funding for WTP standby generator is secured, ARPA funds could be used for other public works priorities:
 - Increase spending on City small diameter water main replacement/overlay program
 - Water Master Plan (in progress) projects
 - Other?

Next Steps

- West Yost team currently preparing preliminary design proposal
- Scope will include:
 - Confirm Genset sizing
 - Review options presented in Pacific Power study
 - Investigate outside funding opportunities and timeframes
 - Prepare recommended plan and estimated cost
- City also working with Pacific Power to complete similar study in conjunction with the wastewater treatment plant project.
