

WALLA WALLA SLEEP CENTER PRE-COVID

- Opened at 1181 W. Rees on 4/25/2019
 - Initial rules required patrons to exit by 9:00 am each day and not return until late afternoon
- Between 4/25/2019-3/25/2020 (334 days) there were 534 calls for WWPD service in the surrounding neighborhood (700 ft radius) not including calls to Sleep Center
 - Approx. I.6 calls a day

WALLA WALLA SLEEP CENTER COVID

- Changed exit rules 3/25/2020
 - Patrons no longer required to exit daily and allowed to stay 24/7
- Between 3/25/2020 5/25/2021 (426 days) there were 340 calls for WWPD service in the surrounding neighborhood (700 ft radius) not including calls to Sleep Center
 - Approx. 0.8 calls a day

WALLA WALLA RECOMMENDATION

- Extend COVID hours of operation
 - Supported by Homeless Alliance
 - Reports that it has not experienced additional problems at Center
 - Feels extended hours allows better access/success for end homelessness efforts
 - Supported by WWPD
 - Anecdotally reported decrease in calls (verified by City Attorney review of calls)
 - City has experience less than half the number of daily calls for neighborhood service w/ COVID hours
 - Greatly helps mitigate neighborhood impacts
