SPECIAL INVITATION
TO
DEDICATION OF THE SWEET HOME PUBLIC LIBRARY

Governor Tom McCall will dedicate the new public library at 2 P. M. ceremonies Sunday, November 23. Open House will follow from 3 to 5 P. M. All librarians and trustees are invited.

Built by Roseburg contractors James and Stritzke, the building has 5,285 square feet and a book capacity of 24,500, more than double the capacity of the previous city hall library.

Funds amounting to \$92,000 from a 1968 bond issue and local taxes, plus a \$88,392 Library Services and Construction Act grant, financed construction and included furnishings and shelving worth \$22,861. The City Council also voted to match a \$2,500 federal grant for non-fiction available in 1969. About \$1,700 in reference books and \$1,500 in new non-fiction volumes were ordered. Carpeting installed throughout the building will improve acoustics and facilitate maintenance.
