## ORDINANCE NO. 37 FOR 1977

## Ordinance No. 711

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THE EAST-WEST ALLEY BETWEEN MAIN STREET, LONG STREET, 10th AVENUE AND 12th AVENUE IN THE CITY OF SWEET HOME, LINN COUNTY, OREGON: PROVIDING FOR STATUTORY PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has initiated vacation proceedings, and has had notices provided, all as required by O.R.S. Chapter 271, and

WHEREAS, no objections have been received to said proposed vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That portion of the east-west alley between Main Street, Long Street, 10th Avenue, and 12th Avenue in the City of Sweet Home, Linn County, Oregon, as described as follows:

A 15 foot wide strip of land the centerline being described as follows: beginning at a point which is N 16° 01' W, 7.5 feet from the northwest corner of Lot 5 of the Donaca Addition to the City of Sweet Home, Linn County, Oregon; thence N 74° 48' E, 99.6 feet to the east line of the Donaca Addition

shall be and is hereby vacated, as provided by O.R.S. Chapter 271 with title to said vacated alley to attach to the lands bordering on such area in equal portions as provided by O.R.S. Chapter 271.

- Section 2. The City Recorder shall file with the County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance, with copies also filed with the County Assessor and County Surveyor, as required by 0.R.S. 271.150.
- Section 3. It is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Sweet Home that this Ordinance go into effect at once, and this ordinance shall be immediately effective and in full force upon its adoption by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
