ORDINANCE BILL NO. 6 FOR 2006

ORDINANCE NO. 1184

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 102, 284, AND 427 CONCERNING STREET NAMES AND BUILDING NUMBERING, WITH AN EXPEDIENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the City of Sweet Homes has a system of naming all streets; and.
WHEREAS, fast growth within the City has nearly exhausted reasonable names for streets within the City creating a need for more flexibility in naming streets, both public and private; and WHEREAS, in order for Public Safety to be able to locate properties being newly created.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sweet Home Municipal Code Section 12.20.030 is amended to read with additional text as follows:

- E. Street names shall be the same for its entire contiguous length and must start and stop entirely within the incorporated City Limits. Streets that are intended to be contiguous when connected, but are not linked together until intervening development occurs, may be named the same. Streets that will not be continued or linked to others of the same name shall be designated unique, non-duplicated names. Street names shall run from intersection center line to center line.
- F. All named streets shall be assigned unique names of trees, shrubs, flowers, or other common plant species.
- G. Alternative naming conventions may be reviewed and accepted for public Subdivisions or Planned Developments, provided the names conform to a cultural, geographical, or historical context.

Section 2. Expediency Clause.

It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare. Therefore, expediency is in order, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval of the Mayor.
