ORDINANCE BILL NO. 4 FOR 1985 ORDINANCE NO. 932

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 368, PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN CERTAIN PRIVILEGE TAXES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sub-section (1) of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 368 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

(1) Devices and games commonly known as pinball or marble games, games commonly known as video games and games of like character are subject to an annual tax of \$75.00, retroactive to January 1, 1985.

Section 2. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 368 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 5. The privilege tax required for amusement devices by this ordinance shall be paid annually in advance before any machine or device shall be displayed or placed in operation. Said tax is on a calendar year basis and shall not be prorated. A machine for which this tax is paid may be replaced by the same operator at the same address with another machine that is in this classification, by notifying the City of the change and the description of the replacement machine, and no additional tax shall be charged thereon for that year.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
