ORDINANCE BILL NO. 19 FOR 1983 ORDINANCE NO. 900

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF LOST PROPERTY

The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

Section 1: If any money or goods valued at less than \$25.00 is found and delivered to the City of Sweet Home, the owner of the money or goods being unknown, the Police Department shall post on the bulletin board in the main corridor of the City Hall of the City of Sweet Home notice of the finding. The notice shall be so posted for thirty (30) consecutive days and shall state the general description of the money or goods found, and the final date before which the money or goods shall be returned to the finder or placed in the general fund of the City of Sweet Home.

Section 2. All money or goods not identified and claimed within sixty (60) days from the date of delivery to the City of Sweet Home shall be returned to the person who delivered the money or goods to the City of Sweet Home. If said person cannot be located, or is a police officer, then the money or property shall be turned over to the City of Sweet Home, liquidated where necessary, and deposited in the general fund of the City of Sweet Home.

Section 3. This ordinance shall apply to all money or goods now held by the Sweet Home Police Department.

Section 4. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety and owing to the urgent necessity, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.
