ORDINANCE NO. 705

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A HOOKUP FEE TO A FEDERALLY-FUNDED SANITARY
SEWER LINE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:


Section 1. (a) All residential and commercial connectors to a federally
funded sanitary sewer line shall pay a hookup charge of \$600 per tax lot.
Industrial users shall pay the "industrial cost recovery" fee in lieu of
hookup charge.

(b) The hookup charge may be paid in full prior to the
initiation of service, or the owner of the property may apply for the
voluntary imposition upon the parcel of a lien for the full amount of the
hookup charge, such lien to be for the life of the bond issued by the
city to pay the local match of the federal grant, plus any interest and
administrative expenses attached to the bond.

(c) All funds derived from the hookup fee on federally-
funded sanitary sewer lines shall be used to retire the bond issued to
pay the local match of the federal grant, and all receipts in excess of
the bonding requirement shall be placed in the Sewer and Water Develop-
ment Fund.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance
shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the
Council and approval thereof by the Mayor.
