ORDINANCE NO. 33 FOR 1977 ORDINANCE NO. 707

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF SWEET HOME, OREGON

WHEREAS, the City of Sweet Home does have traffic and parking control responsibilities within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 380 City Council is responsible for the establishment and alteration of traffic and parking controls; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to delegate certain traffic and parking control responsibilities, to obtain citizen participation in traffic and parking matters, and to strengthen the traffic safety consciousness of the community, NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

- Section 1. <u>Establishment</u>. There is hereby established a Traffic Safety Committee for the City of Sweet Home, Oregon.
- Section 2. Membership. The Traffic Safety Committee shall consist of the Chairman of the City Council Public Safety Committee, the Chief of Police, the City Engineer, and four residents of the City as appointed by City Council. The Chairman of the City Council Public Safety Committee shall be Chairman of the Traffic Safety Committee. A Vice-Chairman shall be elected by the Committee.
- Section 3. Terms of Office. The term of office for the four appointed members shall be for two years. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- Section 4. Powers and Duties. (a) The Traffic Safety Committee shall work closely with the State Traffic Safety Committee and shall seek whatever assistance as would benefit the City of Sweet Home. The Committee shall engage in a Traffic Safety Program within the City to ensure public traffic safety awareness.
- (b) The Traffic Safety Committee shall review all requests to establish or alter traffic controls and parking controls, and all traffic safety problems coming to the attention of the Committee. The Committee shall be empowered to take appropriate action to correct the problems except that major traffic control changes or projects that would be of major expense to the City shall be submitted to the Council for approval by Resolution.
- (c) The Chairman of the Traffic Safety Committee shall report the activities of the Committee to the regular Council meetings.
