

ORDINANCE NO. 34 FOR 1977

ORDINANCE NO. 708

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 696, ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND WAGES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Section 1. The Police Department portion of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 696 is amended as follows:

Police Chief	1
Police Lieutenant	2
Police Sergeant	4
Police Officer/Investigator	5
Dispatch Supervisor	8
Dispatcher/Matron	10
Animal Control Officer	10
Dispatch Relief	4.18/hr

Court Clerk	10

Section 2. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 696 is amended as follows:


Section 3. "Educational Incentives. In addition to the levels of compensation specified in Section 2, employees performing the duties of Police Officer (including Police Lieutenant and Sergeant), Emergency Medical Technician, and Water and Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator (include Chief Operator and Utilities Superintendent), and Engineering Aide shall receive \$15.00 per month for each state certificate obtained in the field related to their job duties. The determination of the maximum number of certificates to be obtained and the determination of whether the certificate is related to the employees's job duties shall be at the discretion of the City Manager."

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval thereof by the Mayor.
