ORDINANCE BILL NO. 3 FOR 1996

ORDINANCE NO. 1094

AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING FROM THE SWEET HOME RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT CERTAIN PROPERTY RECENTLY ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF SWEET HOME.

WHEREAS, certain property, described below, was annexed to the City of Sweet Home, Oregon, by City Resolution on ____April 23..____, 1996, and

WHEREAS, before annexation, the property was located within the boundaries of the Sweet Home Rural Fire Protection District, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing April 23, 1996, for the purpose of hearing any objections to the withdrawal of the property from the Sweet Home Rural Fire Protection District,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Upon the effective date of this ordinance, the following described real property, 940 Poplar Street, Sweet Home, Oregon, which is property in the North 1/2 of Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 1 East, of the Willamette Meridian, Sweet Home, Linn County, Oregon and described as follows is withdrawn from the Sweet Home Rural Fire Protection District:

The Southerly 30.0 feet of even width of land described in Linn County Deed Reference Book 244, page 198 more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Government Lot 2 in said Section 31; thence North 0°13′30″ West along East line of said Lot 2 30.00 feet to a point; thence North 89°56′ West parallel to the South line of said Lot 2 97.98 feet more or less to a point 95.0 feet when measured at right angles from the Easterly right-of-way of 9th Street; thence South 0°11′ East parallel to the said East right-of-way 15.0 feet to the North line of that parcel in Linn County Deed Reference Book 184 page 858; thence East along said North line 5.0 feet to the Northeast corner of said Book 184 page 858; thence South along the East line of said Book 184 page 858 a distance of 15.0 feet to the South line of said Lot 2; thence South 89°46′ East along said South line 93 feet to the point of beginning.
