

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 12 FOR 1992

ORDINANCE NO. 1050

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SWEET HOME ORDINANCE NO. 949 PERTAINING TO REGULATION OF NOMINATIONS FOR CITY COUNCIL; ADOPTING INTO SWEET HOME MUNICIPAL CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 949 is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Nominations. Any qualified elector who has resided in the City at least one year may be nominated for City Council by one of the following methods:

a. A petition to make such a nomination shall be signed by not less than 10 nor more than 20 electors. No elector shall sign more than one such petition, and should an elector do so his signature shall be void as to the petition or petitions last filed. Said petitions shall be filed not earlier than 100 days nor later than 64 days before the election date. Each candidate shall have the signatures of the electors on his/her petition verified by the County Elections Officer, prior to filing the petition with the City Elections Officer.

b. A declaration of candidacy shall be signed and the fee of \$10.00 shall be paid to the City at the time of filing. Said declaration of candidacy shall be filed not earlier than 100 days nor later than 64 days before the election date.

Section 2. This Ordinance is included in the Sweet Home Municipal Code and is hereby made a part thereof (see SHMC 2.04.110 and 2.04.120).

Section 3. It has been determined that the \$10.00 fee herein is exempt from Measure 5 compression.

Section 4. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
