

ORDINANCE NO. 11 FOR 1979

ORDINANCE NO. 765

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC WORKS PERMIT, SETTING FEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

Section 1. A Public Works Permit is hereby established and shall be required for any repair or improvements to streets, curbs, driveways, sidewalks, water lines, sewer lines, storm drains, electrical lines, gas lines, TV cable lines or any other such facility or utility when such repair or improvement shall be made within the public right-of-way. Such repair or improvement shall be made to City standards and shall be initiated only upon twenty-four hour inspection notice to the City.

Section 2. In consideration for issuance of the permit, and individual permit fee of \$20 is established to off-set the issuance and inspection costs. An annual permit may be obtained by utility companies for a fee of \$200.

Section 3. In addition to the permit fee, the City Engineer may require a 10 percent performance bond or \$100 cash deposit with the City, to be retained by the City for a three month period to cover faulty workmanship and material.

Section 4. In the case of an emergency where the public safety health or welfare is concerned, the 24 hour inspection notification is waived. However, the City must be notified of the location where the emergency work was necessary so that follow-up inspection may be performed.

Section 5. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
