

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 16 FOR 1989

ORDINANCE NO. 998

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 886, RELATING TO OFFENSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 35 of Ordinance No. 886 is adopted to read as follows:

Section 35. Unlawful Transport. ORS 164.813, 164.815, 164.825, ~~164.828~~, 164.835, 164.845, 164.855 and 164.863 are incorporated by reference into this ordinance, with all amendments thereto as now enacted or hereafter amended, and a violation or failure to comply with a provision of these statutes is an offense against the City. Where the statutes refer to Court, it shall include Municipal Court and where they refer to County, said term shall be changed to City.

Section 3. Section 36 of Ordinance No. 886 is adopted to read as follows:


Section 36. Sound and Videotape Recording. ORS 164.865 and 164.875 are incorporated by reference into this ordinance, with all amendments thereto as now enacted or hereafter amended, and a violation or failure to comply with a provision of these statutes is an offense against the City.

Section 4. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval of the Mayor.
