

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 6 FOR 1980

ORDINANCE NO. 788

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 707, CREATING A TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF SWEET HOME, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 707 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Membership

(a) The Traffic Safety Committee shall consist of seven voting members: the chairman of the City Council Public Safety Committee and six other persons as appointed by the City Council. No more than one of these voting members may be an official or employee of the City. Not more than two of the members shall be non-residents of the City. To be eligible for appointment, non-City members must reside within the boundaries of Sweet Home School District No. 55.

(b) In addition to the seven voting members, the City Engineer and Police Chief shall serve as exofficio non-voting members of the Traffic Safety Committee.

(c) The chairman of the City Council Public Safety Committee shall be chairman of the Traffic Safety Committee. The vice-chairman shall be elected by the Committee.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
