ORDINANCE NO. 789

AN ORDINANCE INITIATING THE WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT # \_\_\_\_\_

FOR: Juniper Street from the west line of Longway Acres Sub-division to the east line of Shockey's Addition

AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore, on March 25, 1980, by Resolution No. 6 for 1980 directed the preparation of plans and cost estimates for said proposed water improvement, and

WHEREAS, the Council did examine and consider said plans and cost estimate; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 1980, by Resolution No. 6 for 1980, the Council did appoint a Board of Viewers for the purpose of investigating said plans and cost estimates, and said Viewers filed their reports with the City Recorder on April 7, 1980.

WHEREAS, notices of said reports as filed were thereafter given in accordance with Ordinance No. 505, and a public hearing was held on April 22, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Council, being fully advised therein finds it is just and reasonable and in the best interest of the City of Sweet Home to install such water improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The estimated assessments for such improvement are as shown on the attached engineering report.

Section 2. The estimated assessments set out above are hereby declared to be just and proper assessments to the property abutting thereon and benefitted thereby.

Section 3. WHEREAS, it is necessary, and it is for the interest and benefit of the City that this ordinance become effective immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
