ORDINANCE NO. <u>17</u> for 1980 ORDINANCE NO. 799

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 785, PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN CHARGES IN REGARD TO WATER SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 785 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 4. In case any water service payable under this ordinance or any amendment thereof shall not be paid when due, the City shall add a charge of \$1.00 for each notice of the delinquent account that is mailed out. In addition, there shall be a re-connection charge of \$8.50 for each connection, as the cost of reinstating the water service to any property deprived of such service as provided in Section 3 of this ordinance. There shall also be a charge of \$8.50 for turning off a water service at the request of the water user at any time other than regular working hours of the city employees that perform those services. There shall be no fee for turning off and turning on the water service as a courtesy to the water user during the regular working hours of the said city employees.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
