## ORDINANCE BILL NO. 39 for 1978 ORDINANCE NO. 750

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 380, ADOPTING MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS OF THE STATE OF OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 380, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Motor Vehicles Laws of the State of Oregon. The following chapters and provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes are incorporated by reference into this Ordinance as though fully set forth herein, and any violation or failure to comply with such chapters or provisions shall be a violation of this ordinance: Chapter 481, relating to motor vehicle registration and regulation and licensing of dealers and wreckers; Chapter 482, relating to operators and chauffeurs licenses; Chapter 483, relating to motor vehicle traffic, equipment and construction; Chapter 484, relating to traffic safety and traffic offense procedure; Chapter 485, relating to school buses; Chapter 486, relating to financial responsibility; and Chapter 487, relating to rules of the road. Additionally, there are hereby incorporated by reference any other sections or provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes relating to punishment for violations of the motor vehicle laws incorporated hereinabove. The City Attorney shall have the authority to prosecute violations of this ordinance on behalf of the City of Sweet Home.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
