

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 37 FOR 1978

ORDINANCE NO. 748

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Sweet Home a written proposal for annexation to the City by more than half of the landowners who also own more than half of the land in the contiguous territory described below which real property therein represents more than half of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory to be annexed; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 746 was passed, initiating the annexation of said territory, calling a hearing and directing that notice be given thereon, and since the hearing was held at which time all objections or remonstrances with reference to said proposed annexation were considered by the Common Council and since that body feels that annexation is to the best interest of the City and of the contiguous territory; now therefore,


THE CITY OF SWEET HOME ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Annexation Area. It appears to be in the best interest of the City of Sweet Home that the following described contiguous territory be annexed:


Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 5, Township 14 South Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, Linn County, Oregon; thence South on the West line of said section, 275 feet to a point 5.50 feet North of a 1½ inch iron pipe set on the West line of said section; thence East 22 feet to the center of the county road; thence Northerly following the center of said road, 280 feet to the North line of said section; thence West 89 feet to the place of beginning. SUBJECT to the rights of the public in that portion thereof within the boundaries of the county road.

Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Secretary of the State of Oregon (1) copy of this ordinance, (2) a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in the territory annexed, and (3) a copy of Ordinance No. 746 dispensing with an election in the City on the question of annexation. The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds or legal subdivisions, of the new boundaries of the City within ten (10) days of the effective date of annexation to the County Assessor and County Clerk.
