

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT CHARITABLE FRATERNAL AND RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS TO CONDUCT SOCIAL GAMES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Upon obtaining a permit as hereinafter provided, charitable fraternal and religious organizations may conduct social games in accordance with the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes 167.117.

Section 2. The application for the permit to conduct social games shall be made to the Chief of Police of the City of Sweet Home, and the applicant shall furnish such information as he may require. Religious organizations shall not be required to pay any application fee, but other applicants shall pay an application fee of \$25.00, which shall not be refunded if the permit is not granted. As promptly as any appropriate investigation has been made, the Chief of Police shall submit the application for the permit to the Council of the City of Sweet Home. The Council may either grant or refuse the application for the permit.

Section 3. The Council may revoke a permit to conduct social games at any time after holding a public hearing on the matter. The organization holding the permit shall be given at least ten days written notice of the hearing. Such notice shall be delivered to one of the leaders or officers of the organization, and if that cannot be done, then such notice shall be mailed by certified mail.

Section 4. That inasmuch as it is deemed necessary for the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of the city of Sweet Home that the provisions shall be immediately operative, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
