

ORDINANCE NO. 24 FOR 1978

ORDINANCE NO. 735

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF BERYL STREET IN THE CITY OF SWEET HOME, LINN COUNTY, OREGON; PROVIDING FOR STATUTORY PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has initiated vacation proceedings, and has had notices provided, all as required by O.R.S. Chapter 271, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on May 9, 1978,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That portion of Beryl Street described as follows:

A 225.00 foot strip of the 60.00 foot street which is platted as Ash Street in the Charles Altschul's Addition to the Town of Foster as recorded in Vol. 4 Page 17, Linn County Records, Book of Town Plats; the North boundary of said parcel being the South Right-of-Way Line of the platted Third Street; the South boundary being the North Right-of-Way Line of the platted Second Street. Save and except that portion of said parcel lying in Burlington Northern Railroad Right-of-Way.


Second Street is now known as Quince Street. Third Street is now known as Redwood Street. Ash Street is now known as Beryl Street

shall be and is hereby vacated, as provided by O.R.S. Chapter 271 with title to said vacated alley to attach to the lands bordering on such area in equal portions as provided by O.R.S. Chapter 271.

Section 2. The City Recorder shall file with the County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance, with copies also filed with the County Assessor and County Surveyor, as required by O.R.S. 271.150.

Section 3. It is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Sweet Home that this Ordinance go into effect at once, and this ordinance shall be immediately effective and in full force upon its adoption by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
