

RESOLUTION NO. 33 FOR 1973

WHEREAS, the Linn County Commissioners have on several occasions met and conferred in good faith with the residents and elected officials of Sweet Home, and

WHEREAS, these meetings have resulted in \$75,000 of county assistance on the construction of 18th Avenue, county intervention and assistance on the garbage transfer issue, county assistance in obtaining BOR Park funds, county assistance in the obtaining of federal surplus fire fighting equipment and federal surplus generator equipment, resulting in a saving of \$30,000, and emergency assistance in fighting the garbage dumpsite fire, and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing increase in dialogue between the Linn County Commissioners on a broad range of problems from the control of dogs to the provision of building inspections and planning services.

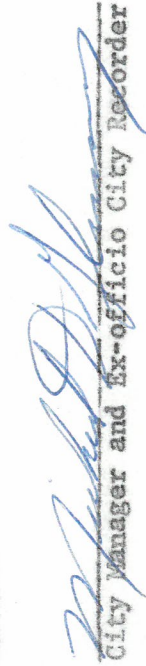
BE IT RESOLVED that the Sweet Home City Council goes on record thanking the County Commissioners and county staff for their assistance and renewed effort to deal with urban problems.
