ORDINANCE NO. 10 FOR 1978 ORDINANCE NO. 721

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 707, CREATING A TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF SWEET HOME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 707 is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

Section 2. Membership. The Traffic Safety Committee shall consist of the Chairman of the City Council Public Safety Committee and six residents of the City as appointed by the City Council. The Chairman of the City Council Public Safety Committee shall be Chairman of the Traffic Safety Committee. The Vice-Chairman shall be elected by the Committee. The Chief of Police and City Engineer shall be ex-officio members of the committee.

Section 2. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 707 is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

Section 2. Terms of Office. The term of office of the six appointed members shall be for two years, except that the following procedure shall be used for initial appointments. At the first meeting of the Traffic Safety Committee the six appointed members shall choose their term of office by lot as follows: three for one year and three for two years. The Traffic Safety Committee shall immediately thereafter notify the City Council in writing of such allotment.

Section 3. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 707 is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

- Section 4. Powers and Duties. (a) The Traffic Safety Committee shall work closely with the State Traffic Safety Committee and shall seek whatever assistance as would benefit the City of Sweet Home. The Committee shall engage in a Traffic Safety Program within the City to ensure public traffic safety awareness.
- (b) The Traffic Safety Committee shall review all requests to establish or alter traffic controls and parking controls, and all traffic safety problems coming to the attention of the Committee. The Committee shall be empowered to make recommendations to the City Council for corrective action.
- (c) The Chairman of the Traffic Safety Committee shall report the activities of the Committee to the regular Council meetings.

Section 4. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
