

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13 FOR 1986

ORDINANCE NO. 949

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE NOMINATIONS FOR COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Elections Officer. The City Manager is the Ex Officio City Recorder, and is also the Chief Elections Officer of the City.

Section 2. Nominations. Any qualified elector who has resided in the City at least one year may be nominated for the Council. A petition to make such a nomination shall be signed by not less than 10 nor more than 20 electors. No elector shall sign more than one such petition, and should an elector do so his signature shall be void as to the petition or petitions last filed. Said petitions shall be filed not earlier than 100 days nor later than 64 days before the election day. Each candidate shall have the signatures of the electors on his/her petition verified by the County Elections Officer, prior to filing the petition with the City Elections Officer.


Section 3. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
