

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 18 FOR 1986

ORDINANCE NO. 956

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TOWING OF UNLAWFULLY PARKED VEHICLES; ADOPTING ORS 98.805, TO AND INCLUDING ORS 98.818; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

Section 1. ORS 98.805, to and including ORS 98.818, are incorporated by reference into this ordinance as though fully set forth herein.


Section 2. The size, shape, content, color, and placement of the signs required by subsection 1 of ORS 98.810 shall be prescribed by the Chief of Police of the City of Sweet Home.

Section 3. The provision in ORS 98.812(1) that states "... and placed in storage at a public garage or public parking lot" is hereby defined to include storage at a parking or storage area or facility operated by a towing service which has a valid towing certificate issued by the State of Oregon, and said towing operator shall have a lien as a garagekeeper or public parking operator under ORS 98.812.

Section 4. Where ORS 98.805 refers to "state," it is hereby defined to include City, and where ORS 98.812 refers to "local law enforcement agency," it is hereby defined to mean Sweet Home Police Department.


Section 5. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval of the Mayor.
