ORDINANCE NO. 917

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 3 FOR 1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 785, PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN CHARGES IN REGARD TO WATER SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 785 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 5 (1). The rates for water used to be charged for each billing period between March 1, 1984 and September 1, 1984 are as follows:

A minimum charge for each water service will be made according to meter size, and a volume of water will be allowed to be used for the minimum charge as follows:

Meter Size	Minimum Monthly Charge	Minimum Allowed
3/4 inch 1 inch 1½ inch 2 inch 4 inch	\$ 6.18 8.98 16.89 24.04 95.49	400 cu. ft. 600 cu. ft. 1,800 cu. ft. 3,000 cu. ft. 15,000 cu. ft.
6 inch	184.80	30,000 cu. ft.

For volumes of water used in excess of the amount allowed for the minimum charge for each meter size the following additional charges shall be made:

For the first 50,000 cu. ft. an additional \$.75 per 100 cu. ft.

For all over 50,000 cu. ft. an additional \$.49 per 100 cu. ft.

For water users outside the city limits, the rate charged shall be one and one-half times the rate charged to water users within the city limits.

(2) The rates for water used to be charged for each billing period after September 1, 1984 are as follows:

A minimum charge for each water service will be made according to meter size, and a volume of water will be allowed to be used for the minimum charge as follows:

Meter Size	Minimum Monthly Charge	Minimum Allowed
3/4 inch 1 inch 1½ inch 2 inch 4 inch 6 inch	\$ 6.75 9.82 18.46 26.28 104.38 202.00	400 cu. ft. 600 cu. ft. 1,800 cu. ft. 3,000 cu. ft. 25,000 cu. ft. 30,000 cu. ft.

For volumes of water used in excess of the amount allowed for the minimum charge for each meter size the following additional charges shall be made:

For the first 50,000 cu. ft. an additional \$.86 per 100 cu. ft.

For all over 50,000 cu. ft. an additional \$.57 per 100 cu. ft.

For all water users outside the city limits, the rate charged shall be one and one-half times the rate charged to water users within the city limits.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
