AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 380, ADOPTING MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS OF THE STATE OF OREGON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 380 is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Motor Vehicles Laws of the State of Oregon. Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484, 485, 486 and 487 of Oregon Revised Statutes are incorporated by reference into this ordinance as though fully set forth herein, and any violation of said statutes as now enacted or hereafter amended shall be an offense against the city. The city attorney shall have the authority to prosecute violations of this ordinance on behalf of the city of Sweet Home.


Section 2. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval of the Mayor.
