

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13 FOR 1984

ORDINANCE NO. 927

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 368, PROVIDING FOR A LICENSE FEE ON CARD TABLES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4, Subsection (2) of Ordinance No. 368, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

(2) Card tables and devices of like character are subject to an annual tax of \$10.00. Games to be played on tables authorized under this section are pinochle, pitch and rummy. The games known as blackjack, poker and similar games are prohibited on tables and devices of like character that are licensed under this Section. Card tables and devices of like character on which the game of pan is played are subject to an annual tax of \$100.00.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
